3. Profile of skills and competences

LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- List and describe the tools, the materials, and the equipment necessary to implement artistic and industrial binding.
- Accurately describe the implementation stages for all types of binding.
- Identify the types of books and binding and accurately describes them.
- Identify the arrangement of the binding machines and facilities and describe the use thereof in all types of production.
- List the stages for preserving worn covers and inside pages for old and new books.
- State the history of the book and binding until today and note the milestones and the change in form in the course of history.
- List the equipment used in the photo-reproduction laboratory and identify the procedure for lithography and editing (assembly of film for the construction of the printing plate).
- Describe the theory of colour and its application on graphic arts.
- Recognize all known methods of printing and name the production stages and special closures related to the stage of bookbinding.
- Know basic chemical elements, which are associated with the binding materials.
- List the tools, files and computer software to create digital files intended for printing forms.
- Identify the EU policy and Greek legislation about the rules of health and safety at work with regards to bookbinding.

SKILLS

- Fold, based on specifications, any printed document with accuracy.
- Handle effectively the tools, the materials, and the equipment necessary for artistic bookbinding.
- Be familiarised with the operation of the machines used in industrial bookbinding and monitors the entire stage of the bookbinding production.
- Evaluate the various orders and organise the type of bookbinding to be applied.
- Evaluate in old bookbinding solutions for improving or rebinding the book and organize the order of works.
- Check for the proper binding of the typographic sheets into a book body and the gluing quality of the cover, in order
 to conduct the necessary quality control prior delivering the books to the customer.
- Be familiarised with the application of health and safety measures at the work area, including the environmental policy in relation to recycling and the protection of the environment.
- Record the productions stages in an order form and establish a basic pricelist of services for the bookbinding procedure.

COMPETENCES

- Follow instructions by the production manager about the performance of his/her duties, understand how to implement them and ensure compliance with the timetables set.
- Undertake independently the bookbinding of books and be responsible for completing his/her works.
- Collaborate with persons of other specialties, such as lithographers, typographers, transporters, suppliers, etc., who are necessary for the production of bookbinding.

The holder of this specialisation certificate may work in the field of Book Binding as a Technician and perform the following professional operations: Artistic Bookbinding - Industrial Bookbinding. The Vocational Training Diploma is recognized as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).

The Certificate supplement provides additional information about the certificate and does not have any legal status in itself. Its format is based on the Decision (EU) 2018/646 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 April 2018 on a common framework for the provision of better services for skills and qualifications (Europass) and repealing Decision No 2241/2004/EC.
