3. Profile of skills and competences

LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to: **KNOWLEDGE**

- Identify the basic morphology and physiology details of plants.
- Match the plants cultivated to the proper method for propagating them.
- Specify the factors for increasing, maturing, and improving the plants.
- List the main diseases and the enemies of plants, including the methods for dealing with them.
- Specify the proper time, method, and means for collecting products.
- Recognise the main races of farm animals and their specifications.
- Describe the basic elements of anatomy and physiology for farm animals.
- State the basic nutrition principles for farm animals.
- Describe the main branches of animal production, the problems and the perspectives, including the major livestock products.
- Recognise the basic principles of edaphology and fertilizing.
- Summarise the types and the varieties of plants of large cultivations, nurseries and floricultural cultivations, along with the soil
 and climate requirements and the cultivation techniques.
- Record the environmental pollution factors coming from farming operations.
- Discern the usefulness and the peculiarities of the organic cultivation and its products.
- State the concept, the objectives and the role of cooperatives.
- Describe the operating method for agricultural machinery.

SKILLS

- Apply the proper cultivation techniques for the preparation of the soil, cultivation after planting, and for soil landscaping after harvesting, using suitable equipment.
- Design an affective system for crop rotation.
- Effectively handle farm animals during the various phases of their lives and productive activities.
- Provide first aid to farm animals for specific illnesses, help them during labour and provide the necessary care to new-born.
- Identify and restore basic malfunctions in agricultural machinery.
- Appropriately handle the farming wastes, e.g. biomass.
- Design stables and installations for seedbeds and greenhouses, considering the suitable installation of necessary equipment.
- Design the necessary irrigation and draining networks for a cultivation.
- Formulate the proper rations for each growing period of farm animals.
- Design and effectively install seedbeds and greenhouses.
- Calculate the various forms of cost and of productive expenses.
- Apply the principles of marketing for the effective marketing of agricultural and veterinary products.
- Evaluate the entire or part of a farming business.

COMPETENCES

- Operate, either autonomously or as a member of a team, every farming business, by considering the factors that affect the productivity of the assets of each farming production.
- Undertake responsibly the farming transactions for the commencement preservation expansion of the farming business.
- Coordinate the works and the necessary procedures for the proper operation of a farming business.
