3. Profile of skills and competences

LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- Critically present the evolution and special characteristics (similarities-differences, advantages-disadvantages) of printed media, radio, television and the Internet as media for providing information and entertainment.
- Interpret terminology (Greek and English) related to journalistic work across the entire spectrum of media (print, television and web-multimedia segment).
- Specify all organizational and issuing procedures of a printed medium (newspaper or magazine), and every responsibility for the human resources working on it.
- Describe the work carried out in a television or radio studio, as well as the groups of specialties involved in them in order to produce a program.
- Distinguish the types of reporting (special features, differences between them) and the corresponding information sources for each type.
- Specify the types of the interview, the methods of preparation and conduct thereof, as well as the presentation-disclosure techniques produced from these contents.
- Comparatively describe the method of operation, the structure and the staffing of news media (journalism organization for printed media, radio station, TV station, internet journalism organization).
- Analyse the advantages and challenges associated with alternative-participatory forms of journalism (such as citizen journalism), the new television systems (web TV, Internet Protocol TV) and multimedia projects for data journalism.
- · Recognize the specificities of journalism expression (spoken and written), across the range of media (printed, radio, TV, and internet).
- Analyse political systems regimes / political ideologies of traditional and modern forms and formulates the principles related to the
 organization and structure of the state within the context of these political realities.
- Explain the role of key organizations and institutions contributing to the formation of international relations between the states.
- Summarize the most important events in relation to contemporary Greek history and the evolution of the European Union (institutions, advantages challenges vulnerabilities in Community actions and decisions).
- Present key elements in relation to public and private law, journalistic ethics and the operation of the supervising authorities of the media.
- Analyse the operation of communication models, communication techniques, and public relations.

SKILLS

- Pronounce and express Greek correctly based on appropriate set of rules and techniques.
- Conduct a comprehensive report by utilizing the appropriate professional equipment and depending on the news medium for which it is intended (newspaper / magazine, radio, TV, internet).
- Successfully perform the realization stages (preparation, conduct, disclosure) for all kinds of interviews, according to the media.
- Prepare or deliver correct information content (news or column), on the domestic or international reality, through the constructive use of domestic or international sources and depending on the specifics of the information media
- Apply techniques and methods for the effective pagination of a document (creating page layouts, prioritizing and titling issues, selecting, processing and classifying photos), to the best promotion of the journalistic content.
- Successfully carry out using professional technical equipment (microphone, headphones, and monitors) radio and television presentation of news-events based on proven description techniques depending on the type of programme (informational, infotainment, educational).
- Make use (either as primary or as secondary material) of suitable photos within the context of bringing forward a journalistic subject and write the appropriate captions.
- · Compose and edit news websites and sports blogs both in terms of content and in terms of layout.
- Make use of all tools of social media
- Apply effective public relation communication techniques or actions.
- Handle with comfort applications related to the use of the computer.

COMPETENCES

- Constructively collaborate with colleagues, managers and technical staff with the aim of creating a sound journalistic project
- Produce journalistic work, both under easy and difficult conditions, imposed by unexpected continuous relocations and irregular hours.
- Perform his/her journalistic role based on the target group and the policy of the journalism organization in which he/she works, without betraying the principles and ethics of his/her profession.
- Look for and maintain constant contact with news events in the domestic and international communication field.
