- Discern the differences at the levels of sports management in our country (school, competitive, mass, professional sports, etc.).

SKILLS

- Prepare budgets, project time schedules and maintain the relevant financial data during the project's progress.
- Agree on the fees of the professionals and bodies involved.
- Organise programmes for the preparation and participation in competitive activities.
- Manage sports events at amateur and professional level.
- Analyse and evaluate the results of statistical or ergometric research.
- Effectively communicate ideas for development, scheduling and expectations, in written form to organisations, associates and/or funding bodies.
- Analyse the cost and the procedures necessary for the completion of a project.
- Negotiate financial details (fees, cost, revenue) with regard to the execution of a project.
- Secure the relevant revenue from sport events (participations, tickets, TV royalties, etc.).
- Handle with comfort applications related to the use of the computer.

COMPETENCES

- Operate based on the code of ethics of his/her profession.
- Act in agreement with the policies and procedures of the organisation employing him/her.
- Operate equally effectively regardless of the type of the project or event (gym, community championship, Olympic Games).
- Be responsible for the issuing of financial and administrative decisions.
- Understand his/her role and the responsibility of collaborating with athletes, coaches, the staff, etc.
- Collaborate effectively as a member of a team.
- Take the initiative, when and where required, with the purpose of solving any problems that may come up.
- Stay constantly up-to-date about the financial and technological developments in his/her field.

The holder of this diploma can be occupied as administration executive in the sports sector, as assistant sports manager in the recreation and athletics sector (sports associations, private gyms, tourist enterprises and hotels, private and public sports camps and sports federations) and as salesperson of sports services and equipment in private enterprises as well as in sports marketing and advertising. The Vocational Training Diploma is recognized as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).

The Certificate supplement provides additional information about the certificate and does not have any legal status in itself. Its format is based on the Decision (EU) 2018/646 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 April 2018 on a common framework for the provision of better services for skills and qualifications (Europass) and repealing Decision No 2241/2004/EC.
