3. Profile of skills and competences

LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- Present spherically and completely the structure and operation of the human body.
- Present the core elements of chemistry, cosmetology, dermatology, and physiology.
- Recognise the types of skins and its conditions, such as acme, dehydration, sensitisation, and possible allergic reactions.
- Identify easily the suitable types of peeling and mask treatments, depending on the type of skin.
- Describe easily the use of the various cosmetology materials for makeup, hair removal and beauty treatments.
- Discern the different methods for sterilizing tools and the skin.
- Show core knowledge of foreign terminology in order to facilitate reading and identifying preparations.

SKILLS

- Apply the most suitable hygiene methods of the industry.
- Arrange tools, devices, cosmetics, and consumables in the allocated work space.
- Select the suitable method for sterilising tools and skin.
- Prepare the booths used for the provision of beauty services for the face, the body, for hair removal, and spa treatments.
- Remove hair using a clip, halawa, cold wax, hot wax.
- Perform with accuracy the suggested massage techniques.
- Grade the stages of cellulite and selects the suitable massage operations, upon receiving the relevant instruction.
- Easily select all cosmetology and auxiliary booth materials required for the treatment protocols.
- Discern and apply easily the make-up styles, depending on the case, the age, and the time of the day.
- Prepare a facial mask, suitable for the treatment under way and place it on the face or body, upon instructions by the person responsible.
- Inform the scientific head about the progress and the proper conduct of treatments.
- Take and record electronically the history and the details of the customer.
- Participate in the promotion and sale of cosmetic preparations.

COMPETENCES

- Act based on the ethics of his/her profession.
- Work under the supervision of the beautician for the provision of beauty services.
- Collaborate with his/her colleagues in order to achieve the objectives of the business.
- Act with consistency and reliability during treatments, in order to avert adverse events and ensure customer satisfaction.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate ³

The holder of this diploma can work as employee of a beauty parlour, in the management of beauty shops or departments, as person in charge of public relations in big commercial and industrial enterprises of cosmetic products, as make-up artist for the theatre, cinema, or television. He/she can also run his/her own studio for physical well-being, depilation and make-up.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).

The Certificate supplement provides additional information about the certificate and does not have any legal status in itself. Its format is based on the Decision (EU) 2018/646 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 April 2018 on a common framework for the provision of better services for skills and qualifications (Europass) and repealing Decision No 2241/2004/EC.
