Profile of skills and competences

LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- Summarise the special characteristics (basic trends) per period in the history of art and costume design.
- Explain the special features with regard to threads and textile design.
- Interpret the terminology (Greek and English) related to costume and fashion design.
- Describe the theories of colours.
- · State the factors affecting the course of fashion, deriving both from the industry and from consumers.
- Describe the professional areas, the equipment, and the specific characteristics (procedures, abilities, limitations), with regard to the creation of apparel collections and the mass production thereof.
- Clearly explain the methods for market research, with the purpose of discovering the buying needs of the target group, including techniques for the effective promotion of products to suitable buyers.
- Specify the steps for preparing a fashion design, based on the principles of freehand drawing, colours, and aesthetics.

SKILLS

- Design clothes and accessories realistically based on the human figure (men women children), respecting the principles that apply to the rates of the human body and its various limbs at different postures.
- Design compositions of clothes for a mannequin (with a non-realistic manner in the fashion figure), by applying suitable shares and textile creases.
- Design clothes and accessories using suitable electronic systems computer software.
- Complete the works concerning a fashion design (selection of design theme, technical drawing for presentation, application of colour and shadows), based on the principles of freehand drawing, colour, and aesthetics in general.
- Select suitable textiles and materials for the production of an apparel collection.
- Accurately manufacture patterns for any type of apparel, using a wide range of textile designs, and based on either industrial measures or custom measures.
- Test the patterns on mannequins, either for validation or for fitting purposes.
- Sew at a professional level with the help of a sewing machine and an overlocker various parts of an apparel and attaches them together, using quality professional techniques.
- Apply internationally patented method for the quick enlargement of patterns from a standard size to multiple sizes, based on international size chart and the target group.
- Cost apparel collections and manage a specific budget intended for the creation and promotion of collections to the market.
- Fully organize the procedures required for the public presentation of an apparel collection: selection of theme and respective setting, of area, accessories, music, lighting, mannequin, speaker and attends to management behind the stage in general.
- Handle with comfort special applications related to the use of the computer.
- Create complete apparel collections, either on his/her own (in the form of self-employment) or as a designer as part of a group in an apparel small or large industry.

COMPETENCES

- Constructively collaborate with all departments of an apparel company, with the purpose of promoting designer collections to the market.
- Work autonomously, in agreement with the changes in aesthetics and with the international technological developments with regard to the design of cloths and costume design.

The holder of this specialisation certificate can work in fashion houses, in cinema / TV / theatre, and in the textile industry.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognized as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).

The Certificate supplement provides additional information about the certificate and does not have any legal status in itself. Its format is based on the Decision (EU) 2018/646 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 April 2018 on a common framework for the provision of better services for skills and qualifications (Europass) and repealing Decision No 2241/2004/EC.
