3. Profile of skills and competences

LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- Recognise the course of the art movements and cultural developments, having created his/her own artistic perception, aesthetic opinion, and critical stance.
- Formulate the basic concepts of marketing, with the purpose of coping with the modern social and financial requirements of his/her profession.
- Narrate the historical developments and influences of ancient holidays and of their expressions, with the purpose of raising the awareness about the cultural - carnival heritage of his/her city for the further development and growth of the institution of Carnival.
- Interpret the language and terminology of the computer and of the 3D Studio.
- Describe the development of the costumes, which affected the formulation of the Carnival costumes.
- Describe the properties and the uses of various materials that could be used in carnival structures.
- List methods for reusing materials and neutralising harmful waste, with the purpose of protecting the environment.
- Separate the materials that are harmful to health from those that are harmless, with the purpose of ensuring the best possible use of suitable materials in carnival structures.
- Recognise the basic principles of freehand drawing and sketching.
- Critically summarise the theories of colours.

SKILLS

- Apply methods for designing the carnival items from different points of view.
- Photograph and print (with or without use of effects), with the purpose of showcasing the points of view and shadows of the Carnival themes.
- Draw items on paper through freehand drawing, renders the space and the relation between the various items and properly set the work.
- Properly render in the freehand design the hues of the light and shadow and design carnival floats.
- Properly render the application media of the various materials on their paper, adopting the basic principles of colour that refer to its practical application at design and space level.
- Render space by designing its three dimensions.
- Sketch through techniques of freehand design various carnival costumes.
- Conceive ideas of satirical, humoristic, and artistic content, for numerous subjects (social, political, financial, and cultural and others that spark his/her imagination).
- Develop three-dimensional models using the traditional way (manually) or with an advanced technological way (PC) on themes (images) assigned to him/her or discovered by him/herself.
- Construct (up to their final form) carnival floats, Jokers, Masquerades and other structures, using various traditional materials.
- Present models (fully casted at a scale smaller than natural) for the themes assigned to or perceived by him/her.
- Organise and monitor a project, by controlling the entire progress of works, until the delivery of the theme.
- Use at basic level the Italian language.

COMPETENCES

- Collaborate with the other members of the team and with different specialties for the design and manufacture of the carnival structures.
- Act consistently and responsibly in every phase of his/her work.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate ³

The holder of this specialisation certificate may work for a carnival organisation (public or private), or as a freelancer, operating his/her own workshop for carnival structures.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).
