KNOWLEDGE

- Demonstrate basic knowledge of dermatology.
- Recall basic information about the history of art, theatre, and cinema.
- Present basic knowledge about the history of makeup over the centuries, along with numerous application styles in the course of ages.
- Recognise the colours, the colour harmony, and the colour combinations.
- Discern the materials used in makeup (makeup powder, shadows, lipstick, rouge) and the behaviour thereof with regard to lighting, time, and different temperatures.
- Demonstrate basic knowledge on costume design and history of hair styling.
- List the rules of hygiene, the method of use, the adverse reactions, the safety conditions for the materials, and the measures to protect from adverse reactions.
- State easily details of facial analysis.

SKILLS

- Select easily the suitable tools for makeup (brushes, sponges, etc.) and the different makeup materials.
- Easily adjust the makeup of persons appearing on TV depending on their roles (e.g. journalists, hosts, guests).
- Create with an excellent manner the makeup for cinema actors, depending on the roles of the script and the filming conditions.
- Adjust accurately the makeup technique for the black & white and for colour photography, for the catwalk, and for advertising.
- Select the suitable methods for disinfecting and sterilising the tools and materials.
- Create special effects with makeup, depending on the script.
- Apply cover makeup, in order to cover skin problems.
- Sufficiently operate a computer and use foreign terminology.

COMPETENCES

- Act based on the ethics of his/her profession.
- Offer his/her services autonomously.
- Collaborate with effectiveness with other professionals, in order to provide the best possible service.
- Communicate and collaborate smoothly with the recipients of his/her services.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate ³

The holder of this diploma can be occupied in TV channels (state and private), in the cinema (production companies), theatre, photography, fashion, publicity (video tapes, video clips, photography, advertising spots, press, newspapers, magazines).

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).
