#### KNOWLEDGE

- State the applications using graphic design (logos, printed media, screens, packaging, etc.).
- Recognize the elements of linear and freehand drawing, of colour and the basic principles of composition.
- Identify the types of printed media and classifies them depending on the use thereof.
- List and describe the printing methods and the productions stages for the printed and multimedia production.
- Interpret and decode the colour of graphical arts and multimedia applications in relation to colour systems, models and conditions.
- Discern and describe the specifications of the fonts, images and graphics of each category.
- Recognise and describe the tools and the environment of the digital software used for the creation and development of applications for printed media, multimedia, and web pages.
- Describe the techniques used for the electronic editing of text, image, layouts, and animation.
- Recognise and describe the aesthetic periods of works of arts, regardless of the time era thereof.
- State the terminology used in graphical arts and multimedia.

#### SKILLS

- Design graphic art solutions for professional applications (printed media, logos, etc.).
- Compose elements such as text, images, graphics and videos for the creation of models for printed media and multimedia.
- Justify the selections behind the visual art solutions suggested.
- Process digital texts, images, animation and graphics in the operating systems provided (Macintosh/PC).
- Operate the peripheral computer support machines, such as the printer, the digital scanner, the memory banks, etc.
- Create and develop web pages.
- Monitor and control the production stages for printed media and multimedia.

#### COMPETENCES

- Follow instructions by the artistic curator about the performance of his/her duties, understand how to implement them and ensure compliance with the timetables set.
- Work independently by taking responsibility for completing his/her work and for the quality of his/her work.
- Collaborate with persons of other specialties, such as copy editors, illustrators, software developers, typographers, etc. in order to implement composite applications.

### 4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate <sup>3</sup>

The holder of this diploma can work as an employee or on a self-employed basis in graphics departments of publishing and advertising companies, in creative offices as well as in private companies, Organizations, Banks, Ministries and other units of the public sector.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).
