3. Profile of skills and competences

LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- Describe the use of the tools, and the composition, the properties, the use of materials, employed within the context of professional theatre - stage make-up in combination with the effect of time, lighting, and temperature to these products.
- Summarise the basic principles of colour combinations and of the theory of colours in general.
- Explain the techniques for formulating the face (ranging from simple formulation to complete transformation), depending on the role - character played by the person on stage, the clothes worn, and the era represented at stage.
- Specify the different morphologies of the face and recognize the characteristics of all types of skin, in combination with their illnesses.
- Interpret the terminology (Greek and English) related to the technical issues of professional theatre - stage make-up.
- Recognise the contribution of exercising and of proper nutrition to the health of the skin and of the body in general.
- Present the special characteristics of the basic periods in the history of theatre.

SKILLS

- Use the suitable materials for the aesthetic care and treatment of all skin types.
- Compose colours with the purpose of achieving harmonious colour shades, depending on the colours of the face, of the clothes, and of the lighting, prevailing during a play.
- Study the morphology of different shapes and types of faces and make any necessary corrections by using suitable materials.
- Formulate the characteristics of an actor/actress or fully transforms his/her face depending on the part - character impersonated and the era depicted in the play.
- Adjust the intensity of the actors' make-up depending on the lighting and the distance between the stage and the spectators.
- Fully perform TV and cinema make-up for a wide range of persons (actors, presenters, journalists, guests), depending on the physiognomy of parts, the direction style and the areas of an audiovisual production.
- Realistically render through the skilful use of products for special effects various face or body transformations: skin injuries and skin lesions.
- Remove hair from any type of skin, with the use of suitable mechanical means or natural / chemical preparations.
- Apply sanitation rules with regard to the use of make-up tools and the work area in general.
- Handle with comfort special applications related to the use of the computer.

COMPETENCES

- Constructively work with all members of a show with the purpose of the best possible aesthetic formulation of the characteristics of the persons appearing on stage.
- Discern the creative and artistic character of his/her work, in order to avoid the "standardization" of his/her work.
- Renew his/her professional practices and knowledge based on new trends in the tools and materials of his/her field.
- Successfully create, renew and present a complete professional portfolio to any possibly interested employer / client, based on the trends in the entertainment industry.
- Adopt when performing his/her work the ethics' principles of his/her profession.
- Effectively deal with problems and difficulties coming within the context of his/her work, using the principles of social psychology.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate ³

The holder of this diploma can work in: theatre, cinema, television, fashion magazines, fashion houses, photo studios.
The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).
