- Properly utter the phonemes and phonetic sound, by applying techniques in the interpretation of the song.
- Apply methods of voice placement for the integrated interpretation of the song, having studied modern interpretation and the modern types of singing.
- Apply techniques for recording and producing a demo, through the constructive use of the options provided by a sound recording studio.
- Read musical text (score, lead sheet) for a song.
- Properly arrange a repertoire, by following the historical repertoire of Greek and foreign songs.
- Choreograph and have the absolute control of the motions of his/her body.
- Apply methods of expression acting as well as vocal training control methods in signing.
- Make use of the basic music terminology in English.
- Contribute to the effort for the rendering, recording and salvation of Greek musical tradition, by constructively participating in cultural actions for the dissemination of Greek music.
- Handle with comfort special applications related to the use of the computer.

- Collaborate with ease with the other members of the team, in order to achieve their objectives.
- Work autonomously in live appearances or recordings.

The holder of this specialisation certificate may work in live shows in concert areas, clubs, radio and TV stations, and in recordings in collaboration with record labels.
