LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

#### **KNOWLEDGE**

- Identify the methods of creative use and monitoring of the MIDI technology.
- Specify the contribution of the choir song to the formulation of a musical perception.
- Describe the abilities of the most popular musical instruments through the acquired acoustical experience.
- Recognise the methods for cultivating the musical perception using the ear and the voice as the medium.
- Describe the most important events in the development of musical art through the critical approach of the main trends and movements.
- Analyse the form in the architecture of the musical works, from the simplest to the most composite forms.
- Identify the most important techniques for sound composition.
- Critically interpret the basic structural data in musical creation, through the languages of the musical movements and trends of the 20<sup>th</sup> century, with the purpose of cultivating new stimuli and perceptions in musical composition.
- Present the specifications of the modern labour market, as well as of the specialty's application field.
- Comparatively describe the specificities of the music intended for theatrical, cinema, radio, TV and multimedia production.
- Specify the basic pedagogical principles for the teaching of methods for the cultivation of musical perception.
- Formulate the communication techniques, as well as the basic trends of modern entrepreneurship.
- Narrate the role of modern technology in live musical expression and the various systems of creation processing of musical and acoustic material in concerts.
- Recognise the language and the special terminology of computers.

#### **SKILLS**

- Prepare acoustic designs, having a proper understanding of the phenomenon of sound.
- Operate a variety of machinery for recording, processing and reproducing audio.
- Use the key-bearing instrument (every musical instrument using a musical keyboard) as a means for inputting data to computer.
- Apply the basic principles of sound engineering.
- Use MIDI sequencing.
- Apply the basic processing and mixing techniques for sounds in special consoles.
- Program and control various synthesizer categories.
- Operate computer software for the importing, processing, and issuing of musical scores.
- Record, process and mix audio material in a hard drive.
- Make use at a basic level of the terminology of his/her specialty in English.
- Attend to the musical aspects of events, shows, and concerts.
- Process audio material with musical data in the professional and amateur factor.
- Conduct, at technical level, musical productions, concerts, school theatrical plays.
- Apply the basic principles of musical technology in the studio.
- Create scores and writings with regard to music.
- Design and prepare pages in the internet or in a CD-ROM.

#### **COMPETENCES**

- Constructively collaborate with the other human resources of a radio or TV programme.
- Formulate his/her professional practice based on the principles of his/her professional ethics.
