3. Profile of skills and competences

LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- State the principles of sterilization disinfection antisepsis for the staff of the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), the patients and the material-pharmaceutical equipment thereof.
- Describe the basic macroscopic anatomy of the human body.
- State the normal range of the human vital signs (respirations, pulses, blood pressure, and temperature).
- State the measures to prevent the spreading of nosocomial infections and pathogens and the importance thereof.
- Interpret the terms "sedated patient", "shock", "hemodynamic instability", "brain death", "resistant microbe strain".
- List the main functions of the ICU key machinery: monitor, ventilators, blood gas analyzer, suctions defibrillator.
- Explain the basic principles for the physiology of the respiratory, cardiovascular and urinary system.
- List the main tools and medicines used during patient intubation and cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

SKILLS

- Treat the patient and the material and pharmaceutical equipment of the ICU in accordance with the protocols for antisepsis-sterilization-disinfection.
- Prepare, in collaboration with the nurse, the bed to accommodate the patient according to the protocols of the ICU, before the hospitalization of the patient.
- Check the operation of the monitor and whether or not it is connected to cables for ECG and taking vital signs, in order to inform the nurse responsible for the immediate use thereof.
- Prepare the ventilator and suction to be readily accessible and ready for use.
- Collaborate with the nurse to remove all clothing and bedding of the patient to be received.
- Place the patient in bed at the position indicated by the physician.
- Under the guidance of nurse responsible, connect the patches for the ECG sensors to record the vital signs of the
 patient.
- Prepare the cart with the tools and medicines that will be requested by the physician based on all sterilization rules.
- Undertake the shaving, cleaning and decubitus ulcers in a patient's body, in accordance with the instructions of the medical staff.
- Receive materials used and classify them properly for sterilization or disposal.
- Take appropriate measures to restrain / immobilise the patient to avoid the accidental removal of tubes and drains under the instructions of the nurse responsible.
- Supervise the operation of machines and their indications, while informing the nurse about any abnormalities.
- Record the quantity and quality of secretions from the various drains on the patient and informs the nurse responsible.
- Undertake the cleanliness and disinfection of the various orifices, drains and catheters placed on the patient.
- Take care and prepare the body of the deceased patient (removal of catheters, tubes, etc.).

COMPETENCES

- Work under the supervision of the responsible nursing and medical personnel.
- Collaborate with the healthcare professionals of the ICU for the continuous updating and psychological support both to the patient and to his/her relatives.
- Work in accordance with the ethics of his/her profession with reliability, respect and confidentiality, both towards patients and colleagues.

The Certificate supplement provides additional information about the certificate and does not have any legal status in itself. Its format is based on the Decision (EU) 2018/646 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 April 2018 on a common framework for the provision of better services for skills and qualifications (Europass) and repealing Decision No 2241/2004/EC.

The holder of this diploma can be employed in Intensive Care Units as an assistant to nurses and attendant doctors and as a participant in therapeutic operations that correspond to the level and subject of his/her education, specialization and experience.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).
