- Present the details of safe and environmentally-friendly driving.
- Describe the basic principles of First Aid.
- Identify the basic principles of economy, organization and management of businesses.
- Locate geographical landmarks, tourism landmarks and streets, by using driving maps and guides.
- Understand the method of operation of computers, IT systems and telecommunication systems.
- Present historical and cultural elements with regard to our country and areas of cultural and tourism interest.
- Summarise the basic principles of social behaviour, psychology and customer service.
- Recognise the basic principles of written and oral communication in English.

SKILLS

- Identify the key mechanical problems of a car.
- Drive safely and with an environmentally friendly manner his/her vehicle.
- Provide first aid.
- Treat his/her vehicle using financial methods, as a business.
- Use telecommunications and IT media.
- Find his/her orientation, plan and take routes for road transports.
- Perform road tours and present basic information about the sights.
- Communicate in writing and orally in English.

COMPETENCES

- Responsibly perform road transports, based on the applicable legislation in the safest and most affordable way.
- Autonomously deal with urgent road incidents, such as accidents or vehicle break-downs.
- Autonomously manage his/her vehicle in an affordable, effective and environmentally-friendly way.
- Serve and communicate with customers of different nationalities and tourists.

The holder of this specialisation certificate may work as a taxi driver.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).

The Certificate supplement provides additional information about the certificate and does not have any legal status in itself. Its format is based on the Decision (EU) 2018/646 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 April 2018 on a common framework for the provision of better services for skills and qualifications (Europass) and repealing Decision No 2241/2004/EC.
