KNOWLEDGE

- List at least four (4) historical periods with archaeological and museum interest (early and later antiquity, Byzantine, medieval, modern period).
- Sufficiently formulate issues of archaeological legislation.
- Recognise the elements comprising the art of ancient Greek civilisation (architecture, sculpture, and painting).
- Identify the forms of wear in works caused by natural agents (temperature, humidity, insects, and light).
- Interpret communication, supervision or alarm signal flow charts and identify the devices of the safety systems and of the communication equipment.
- Easily report the measures for protection in the event of earthquake or fire.
- Recognise the parts and functions of the human body.
- Formulate basic concepts of computer operating systems.
- Communicate satisfactory in at least one foreign language.

SKILLS

- Easily handle computer software both for the surveillance of areas and infrastructure, and for the office environments.
- Clearly prepare, orally and in writing, reports about events and situations.
- Analyse information about conditions and events.
- Easily operate the electronic equipment for communications, for access control, and for safety.
- Directly and effectively act in the event of alarm (actual or due to error).
- Attend to the proper operation (maintenance) of the safety systems and reset them in case of malfunction or drill.
- Identify dangerous conditions and foresees the coming reactions (panic).
- Calmly take action in emergencies (earthquake, fire, flood, armed encounter) by applying anything provided in the plan for dealing with it (protection of visitors, personnel, museum contents, etc.).

COMPETENCES

- Operate based on the code of ethics of his/her profession.
- Act in agreement with the policies and procedures of the organisation employing him/her.
- Be constantly alert and responds immediately when necessary.
- Understand the size of the emergency and reacts calmly.
- Communicate effectively with visitors, colleagues, and supervisors.

The holder of this diploma can be occupied in archaeological sites, museums, monasteries and churches, galleries, private museums, art collections of organizations, banks, industries or other private institutions.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).
