3. Profile of skills and competences

LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- Identify the operation and the accessories of the photographic camera.
- Classify the photographic cameras between digital and analogue and state the basic categories thereof.
- · Accurately describe the small and large format cameras and list their advantages and disadvantages.
- List the types of film and filters, and state their properties.
- · State the techniques for measuring and managing natural and artificial lighting.
- Discern and describe the techniques for taking and processing black & white and colour photography.
- List the stages for transporting the optical image to firm (photo-sensitometry).
- Understand the basics of drawing, of colour and the basic principles of composition.
- Discern the milestones in the history and technological evolution of photography, including the basic periods in art history.
- Recognise the method of operation of optical communication in relation to his/her specialty.
- · State the basic principles of advertising and marketing.
- Recognise elements of sociology in photography and image semantics.
- State the aspects of law and of professional ethics for his/her specialty.

SKILLS

- Effectively operate all photographic cameras and their equipment.
- Combine speed shutter and sensitivity (ISO) along with the field of depth in every aspect of photo-shooting.
- Select the suitable lenses, such as wide-lens, normal, telephoto, shift, fish eye and zoom, depending on the subject.
- Handle artfully all lighting sources, depending on the type of photo-shooting.
- Properly apply the stages for the production of advertising photography (models, artistic proposals, final takes).
- Successfully operate photographic cameras in the following settings: Landscape, portrait, fashion, wedding, baptism,
 reporting (small format) and for the following shootings: architectural, industrial, still life composition of small items, still life
 (large format).
- Develop film and prints black & white photos in dark rooms.
- Effectively use photographic filters.
- Operate image editing software (Photoshop, etc.) in order to edit the photographic image.

COMPETENCES

- Follow instructions by the artistic curator and understand the method for applying them, while complying with the time schedules set.
- Collaborate with persons of other specialties, such as fashion designers, hair dressers, graphic designers, etc. for a complex professional photo shoot.
- Undertake independently photo-shoots of private and professional nature and is responsible for the quality of his/her work.

The holder of the diploma of this specialization can work in organized studios of applied photography and image of the public or private sector and as a freelancer.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).

The Certificate supplement provides additional information about the certificate and does not have any legal status in itself. Its format is based on the Decision (EU) 2018/646 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 April 2018 on a common framework for the provision of better services for skills and qualifications (Europass) and repealing Decision No 2241/2004/EC.
