3. Profile of skills and competences

LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- Classify the cultivation works required before and after the installation of the vineyard.
- Explain the criteria for selecting the specific vine and the methods for its propagation.
- Demonstrate the arrangement of the plants of the vineyard to be installed, and the methods for supporting it.
- Specify the negative impacts of pests for the vineyard.
- Classify the different methods for pruning the vine.
- Specify the methods for irrigating the vine, the application method thereof, and explain irrigation affects the quality of wine products.
- Describe how grapes evolve, from the flowering period until its complete maturation.
- Analyse the properties of the must and how they can be affected during wine making.
- Describe the properties and the effect of sulphur dioxide to wine.
- Present the procedure for making white and red wines, including their types.
- Present the method for using the required tools of the wine harvest.

SKILLS

- Perform the cultivation works and care of the vine, using suitable tools with accuracy.
- Suggest the proper way for using pesticides, wine-making machine and tools, for the safety of employees.
- Estimate the time for commencing the vine harvest.
- Specify with the use of suitable equipment wine acidity, sugar, ethyl alcohol, sulphuric acid and iron content.
- Conduct quality control to the wine products.
- Select the environment that is suitable of installing the vineyard.
- Identify the basic illnesses of grape diseases.

COMPETENCES

- Sufficiently manage the vine and wine products.
- Follow the scientific instructions provided by the agronomists responsible and sufficiently performs any tasks assigned to him/her.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate ³

The holder of this diploma can work in viticultural, wine-making or mixed viticultural companies of different kinds, covering technical, organizational, and administrative needs in all production, manufacture and trade stages (e.g. private, association or state vineyards, seedbeds, wine-industries, raisin factories, trade and standardization institutions, oenological laboratories, institutions and research centres, Ministry of Agriculture etc.)

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).
