LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- Interpret the terminology (Greek and English) related to costume and fashion design.
- Describe the special machines and materials used for the creation of leather goods (clothes, shoes, and leather accessories).
- Summarise the special characteristics (basic trends) per period in the history of art and costume design.
- Recognise modern trends developed with regard to the organisation management of businesses, the methods for applying
 the principles of marketing in the operation of a modern business, and the basic concepts principles procedures of general
 accounting.
- Formulate the basic principles and concepts of commercial and labour law.
- · Clearly explain the procedure and use of tanning.

SKILLS

- Design leather clothes, shoes and leather accessories realistically based on the human figure (men women children), following the principles that apply to the analogies of the human body and its various limbs at different postures.
- Design compositions of leather clothes and accessories for a mannequin (with a non-realistic manner in the fashion figure), by applying suitable shares and textile creases.
- Operate specialized software in the computer for the design of leather items (clothes, shoes and other objects).
- Complete the works concerning a fashion design for leather items (selection of design theme, technical drawing for
 presentation, application of colour and shadows), based on the principles of freehand drawing, colour, and aesthetics in
 general.
- Accurately manufacture patterns for any type of leather apparel, using a wide range of leather textile designs, and based on
 either industrial measures or on custom measures.
- Test the patterns on mannequins, either for validation or for fitting purposes.
- Sew with the help of professional machines various parts of leather item (apparel, shoe, and accessory) and assemble it, based on quality professional techniques.
- Cost leather goods collections (apparel, shoes, and other items) and manage a specific budget intended for the creation and promotion of collections to the market.
- Fully organize the procedures required for the public presentation of a leather goods collection: selection of theme and respective setting, of area, accessories, music, lighting, mannequin, speaker and attend to management behind the stage in general.

COMPETENCES

- Create integrated collections of leather apparel, shoes and other leather goods, either on his/her own (in the form of self-employment) or as a designer and technician in relevant businesses and factories.
- Constructively collaborate with every department in a leather goods company (for apparel, shoes, and accessories) with the purpose of promoting quality collections in the market.
- Design, cut and sew leather apparel, shoes and other leather accessories by following the trends of fashion and processing the respective data.
- Follow the changes in aesthetics and the international technological developments with regard to the design of leather items (apparel, shoes, and accessories).

The Certificate supplement provides additional information about the certificate and does not have any legal status in itself. Its format is based on the Decision (EU) 2018/646 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 April 2018 on a common framework for the provision of better services for skills and qualifications (Europass) and repealing Decision No 2241/2004/EC.
