3. Profile of skills and competences

LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- Describe in summary the physiology and the anatomy of the eye.
- State the type of eye lenses (converging, diverging) and the specifications thereof.
- Specify the main optical materials, the applications thereof, their advantages, disadvantages, and the limitations in the use of each material.
- List the most common morphological and structural abnormalities of the eye and the main defects of vision (myopia, presbyopia, astigmatism, and hyperopia).
- List the tools and instruments that make up the machinery of a laboratory in an optical store.
- State the basic safety rules for a laboratory in an optical store.
- Formulate the principles and conditions for establishing and operating a store for the sale of optical products.
- Present the general principles for personal and public hygiene.
- State the main infectious diseases, the contagion method thereof and the rules of protection.

SKILLS

- Select and prepare the suitable materials and tools in order to manufacture the prescribed structure (e.g. myopia lenses).
- Attend to the cleanliness and order of the work benches at the laboratory for optical products, following the rules of safety and hygiene.
- Attend to the proper presentation of the goods for sale (frames for eyeglasses, contact lenses, liquids for cleaning lenses, etc.) as per the guidelines of marketing.
- Participate in the execution of ophthalmic prescriptions for the processing of lenses and eyeglasses, as per instructions.
- Check for any shortages in materials, consumables and frames, and place the respective orders.
- Attend to and arrange the materials, tools, and consumables of the laboratory, as per the safety and health regulations.
- Report any problems concerning the operation / maintenance of the machines and, upon approval by the person in charge, can organize the relevant repairs.

COMPETENCES

- Work under the supervision of a certified Optician or Optometrist.
- Operate in accordance with the principles, procedures, policies, and philosophies of his/her professional field.
- Collaborate effectively with all business departments.

The holder of this specialisation certificate may work as an optical laboratory technician, in an optical store, in the industry of optical products or as a support technician for optical devices and machines used in an optical laboratory. The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).

The Certificate supplement provides additional information about the certificate and does not have any legal status in itself. Its format is based on the Decision (EU) 2018/646 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 April 2018 on a common framework for the provision of better services for skills and qualifications (Europass) and repealing Decision No 2241/2004/EC.
