3. Profile of skills and competences

LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- Describe the course of artistic movements and cultural developments, by approaching the history of art with artistic criteria.
- Describe the development of the costumes, which affected the formulation of the Carnival costumes.
- Specify the technical capabilities for the treatment of leather and the design requirements of mass production.
- Describe the specifications of the work area used for the construction of the carnival costumes, and the production procedures.
- Recognise anything related to the threads, the manufacturing thereof, the various weaving and braiding, the dyeing and imprinting techniques for the most suitable selection and combination of textiles.
- Specify the basic principles of marketing.
- Describe the historical developments and impacts of the ancient holidays and expressions, along with the development of the institution of the Carnival.
- Interpret the language and terminology of the computer and of the 3D Studio.

SKILLS

- Create the pattern of any costume through the use of geometry and make any necessary amendments.
- Create a pattern from a photograph or sketch at a suitable form in order to be used for mass production.
- Create a pattern, using his/her own designs, both based on industrial measures and custom-made (with body defects or not).
- Sketch through freehand design carnival and other costumes, adopting the principles of human analogies.
- Sketch physical objects on paper, with a naturalistic rendering of the light tones and shades, of the texture of fabrics and of colour, by properly placing the subject.
- Properly render the application media of the various materials on their paper, adopting the basic principles of colour that refer to its practical application at design and area level.
- Compose objects with different materials, making use of his/her imagination.
- Adopt the basic principles of drawing, cutting and sewing, with the purpose of experimenting on various forms and volumes (at a comparative or combining level).
- Create through a computer, realistic 3D imaging of the Carnival themes, of the materials to be constructed, and of the environment where they shall be placed.
- Develop three-dimensional models using the traditional way (manually) or with an advanced technological way (PC) on themes (images) assigned to him/her or discovered by him/herself.
- Discover various materials (outside his/her specialized field) with the purpose of producing pioneering compositions and creating new objects, governed by originality and proper aesthetics.
- Conceive and suggest ideas of satirical, humorous, and artistic content, for numerous subjects (social, political, financial, cultural and others that spark his/her imagination).
- Use at basic level the Italian language.

COMPETENCES

- Work either as a freelancer or as a specialist in a Carnival costume industry.
- Organise and monitor a carnival costume project, by controlling the entire progress of works, until the delivery of the theme.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate ³

The holder of this specialisation certificate may work in a carnival costume business, in a clothes workshop or small business, or in a sewing atelier or as a freelancer with his/her own carnival costume workshop.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).
