3. Profile of skills and competences

LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- Describe the basic principles governing acting, and the dominant styles of acting.
- Specify the basic techniques for the proper utterance of Greece and for the conscious utterance of speech in general.
- Describe the evolution of stages and costume design in centuries, with special emphasis paid on modern theatre and on the use of modern technology.
- Describe the best works of international theatrical production, through the structure of the works, character development, the style of speech, etc.
- State the history of Greek and international theatre, the main theatrical writers, and the evolution of writing, acting, and of the stage.
- Describe the various parts of a play, in order to be functional.
- Comparatively specify the characteristics of the expressive arts (theatre, opera, musical, dancing play, etc.).
- Describe the basic principles of communication techniques.
- Specify the basic group psychology and behaviour principles, in order to handles its changing dynamics.
- Interpret the basic terminology of directing (both in Greek and in English).

SKILLS

- Record the needs of a theatrical play in human resources and technical means and then participate together with the producers in the selection of suitable crews and technical means.
- Prepare in detail an effective time schedule for the preparation of a theatrical play.
- Prepare actors for the proper performance of their parts (both in terms of movement and in terms of uttering speech and expressing emotions), depending on the requirements of the theatrical work.
- Present to the actors basic techniques for uttering speech and externalising emotions through the use of the body.
- Apply numerous directing techniques depending on the type of the play (theatrical plays for adults and children, cultural events in closed and open areas, cultural events, variety, shows, circus shows, opera, musical, Musical Theatre, etc.).
- Effectively supervise the proper execution of a theatrical play.
- Handle with comfort special applications related to the use of the computer.

COMPETENCES

- Constructively collaborate with the creative and technical workforce of a theatrical production, with the purpose of ensuring the best possible rendering of a theatrical play.
- Follow the ethics principles of his/her profession, within the context of directing.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate ³

The holder of this specialisation certificate may work in theatrical plays, cultural events in indoor or outdoor venues, artistic events, variety shows, shows, circus shows, opera plays, musical plays, or musical theatre.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).
