LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES). A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- List and describe the structural parts comprising a simple watch mechanism (simple winding watch).
- Recognise and describe the operating systems in a simple watch mechanism (simple winding watch).
- Recognise and describe the technical terms of watch-making, regardless of their language of origin.
- List the tools, the materials, and the equipment for the maintenance procedure of any watch mechanism.
- Describe the maintenance stages through a manual or mechanical method and the stages for dismantling and assembling a watch mechanism.
- Recognize the most important types of watch regardless of the date of manufacture thereof.
- State the simple and self-winding systems.
- Analyse a mechanical drawing in relation to his/her specialty.
- State the development stages of watch-making.
- Describe the procedure for manufacturing watch-making accessories.

SKILLS

- Assembly and dismantle accurately a winding watch.
- Maintain (cleaning, lubrication) with a manual and mechanical method a watch mechanism.
- Identify malfunctions and suggest restoration solutions.
- Can design accessories for a watch mechanism intended for restoration in workshops of other specialties (machine shop, goldsmith, etc.).
- Easily operate the machinery and the tools necessary in watch making.

COMPETENCES

- Work independently and undertakes the responsibility of maintaining and repairing each watch.
- Work under a technical supervisor, understand the instructions provided and take care for complying with the time schedules set.
- Collaborate with persons of other specialties, such as designers, engineers, electronics, goldsmiths, etc., for the repair and maintenance of a watch.

The holder of this specialisation certificate may work in workshops manufacturing, repairing, and selling clocks and watches.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).

The Certificate supplement provides additional information about the certificate and does not have any legal status in itself. Its format is based on the Decision (EU) 2018/646 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 April 2018 on a common framework for the provision of better services for skills and qualifications (Europass) and repealing Decision No 2241/2004/EC.
