KNOWLEDGE

- Formulate basic concepts of computer (Windows and Mac OS) operating systems.
- List at least four (4) video engineer software applications.
- Clarify terms from a vocabulary of specialized terminology.
- Discern the basic types of shots and camera movements.
- List the types of transition / mixing from shot to shot and the role of each of them.
- Discern the differences in the various cinema, TV and new media formats.
- Identify all information provided by the Waveform Monitor and the Vectorscope.
- Interpret the signal flow charts (for video and sound).
- Perceive the rhythm of the musical work depending on its type.
- Clarify the basic areas for acoustic frequencies (Hi, Mid, Low).

SKILLS

- Sufficiently apply the editing techniques for the various types of audiovisual production.
- Apply, based on the script, the techniques and procedures for processing videos and optical effects that are necessary for the completion of an audiovisual production.
- Properly connect and configure the devices necessary for processing (audio & video) as per the respective signal flow chart.
- Process videos of various types (documentaries, fiction, short films, interviews, advertisements, etc.) at a professional level.
- Easily conduct work in Avid and Final Cut.
- Apply a wider range of video/sound processing and optical/audio effects techniques using all devices and applications provided in an editing suite (editing, mixing, colour connection, DVE, etc.).
- Import, formulate and integrate sound and music in the video/film.
- Perform "rough cutting" for cinema films.

COMPETENCES

- Operate based on the code of ethics of his/her profession.
- Act in agreement with the policies and procedures of the medium or organisation employing him/her.
- Operate equally effectively regardless of the type of the audiovisual production (TV, cinema, new media).
- Perform equally effectively in an environment with systems of multiple cameras for live broadcasting (news, information shows, sports, TV games, concerts, etc.) and for recorded productions.
- Operate autonomously or as a member of an editing team, collaborating in the same production.
- Take the initiative, when and where required, depending on his/her specialization and experience.
- Stay constantly up-to-date about the technological developments in his/her field.

The holder of this diploma can be occupied in TV stations, TV programme production companies, image or sound production and editing studios, advertising spots production companies, multimedia presentations companies, recording studios, concert halls etc.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector falling in the category S.E. (Secondary Education) according to the Presidential Decree no.50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol.A/5-3-2001).
