- Describe the basic concepts of directing.
- Identify the technique and style of creation and of the creators of Ancient Drama and Comedy.

SKILLS

- Properly utter speech in Modern Greek, by successfully applying the Speech Training Principles.
- Develop the strength and promotion of his/her speech with the proper use of his/her diaphragm.
- Cope with the requirements regarding moving and dancing, concerning the roles cast to him/her.
- Apply techniques for the musical expression depending on the musical needs of a theatrical play or cinema film.
- Control all other means of expression, in addition to speech, and find way to externalize emotions with the use of the body.
- Interpret roles cast to him/her from any repertoire.
- Apply the understanding of a theatrical text in order to properly portray and enrich the character called to act.

COMPETENCES

- Constructively work within strict time limits with the human resources of the theatrical or cinema production with the purpose of ensuring the best possible transfer of a scenario on stage or on the big screen.
- Work responsibly, seeking self-knowledge and discipline in the performance of his/her work.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate ³

The holder of the Diploma of this specialisation can be employed in advertising, movies or theater.
