The VET graduate of this specialty may work as transcriptionist in the private or public sector or as freelance professional, offering digital files transcription services, such as medical reports, court judgments, Board of Directors/Town Councils minutes, scientific events, legal arbitrations, interviews, workshops, focus groups, in depth interviews etc.

The Diploma is recognized as a formal qualification for recruitment in the public sector in the category Secondary Education by virtue of the PD 50/2001 (Government Gazette. 39/A′/5-3-2001), as in effect.

The Certificate supplement provides additional information about the certificate and does not have any legal status in itself.
