LEARNING OUTCOMES (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, COMPETENCES).

A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- Interpret the terminology associated with sports journalism in every medium of communication separately (TV, radio, printed media, internet) and explain the terminology and specifics regarding a wide range of sports.
- Describe the research techniques for sports news-issues, including the methodology of sports reporting.
- Specify all organisational and issuing procedures of a sports newspaper, the organisation and production of a television or radio studio, and every responsibility for the human resources involved.
- Recount significant events from the history of Greek and international sports, as well as from the Greek and international sports news.

SKILLS

- Pronounce and express Greek correctly based on appropriate set of rules and techniques.
- Conduct successfully, by using professional equipment (headphones, microphone, and monitor), radio and television sports casting using various proven descriptive techniques.
- Apply techniques and methods for the effective pagination of a document (creating page layouts, prioritising and titling issues, selecting, processing and classifying photos), to the best promotion of the sports content.
- Plan and perform all work steps of the sports reporter (award or finding of subject, collection of information, research, creation / presentation of reports) on all media (print, radio, TV, internet) within the limited time frame specified by the editor.
- Make use (either as primary or as secondary material) of suitable photos within the context of bringing forward a journalistic subject and writes the appropriate captions, text captions, video and other visualised material and data.
- Hold and make use of all social media tools aiming at publishing and distributing sports content.
- Readily handle applications related to computer use.

COMPETENCES

- Serve the journalistic profession based on the current rules of journalistic ethics (at national and international level), as well as the principles set out in the relevant laws on media.
- Constructively collaborate with colleagues, managers and the technical staff of a radio/TV station, a journalistic organisation, a website or a media group, with the aim of creating a sound journalistic project regarding sports events.
- Formulate their professional identity and practice based on the laws on media and the principles of journalistic ethics.
- Produce journalistic work, both under easy and difficult conditions, imposed by unexpected-continuous relocations and irregular hours.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate ³

The holder of the Diploma of this specialisation can be employed as a journalist, reporter or presenter of sports shows and sports news on TV channels and radio stations, as a journalist or reporter in newspapers, in the periodical press, websites, news agencies, as a contact person for press offices of unions, federations or various sports events, in sports marketing – management companies.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector according to the Presidential Decree no. 50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol. A/5-3-2001), as currently in force.
