- List and quote the Pharmaceutical Code of Ethics basic provisions.

SKILLS

- Execute various types of prescriptions, explain said prescriptions, provide the public with the appropriate instructions, cost the prescriptions, conduct the sale process, collect the price and issue the legal vouchers, pursuant to the pharmacist's instructions.
- Receive, inspect, store, package and safeguard medicines, parapharmaceuticals and raw materials in appropriate storage areas and warehouses pursuant to the regulations.
- Apply product costing techniques and basic accounting principles (invoicing, VAT).
- Order medicines and parapharmaceuticals, and supervise any return of goods in order to maintain stock as needed, pursuant to the pharmacist's instructions.
- Prepare galenical preparations, pharmaceuticals and cosmetics in the pharmacy laboratory, operate and maintain the pharmaceutical laboratory equipment under the pharmacist's supervision.
- Verify the composition of raw materials and products, and apply specifications and established preparation regulations for the exact composition of the prepared product, utilising the relevant organology.

COMPETENCES

- Serve the pharmacy's customers, provide medicines, OTC medicines, implement promotion techniques for food supplements and parapharmaceuticals, manage and complete transactions under the pharmacist's supervision.
- Handle and support the pharmacy's management, take care of and attend to its image and operation.
- Provide pharmaceutical and prevention services to customers and be informed about new pharmacy products.
- Adopt rules of health and safety in the workplace, assess any risks and take the necessary precaution and protection measures.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate ³

The holder of this diploma can work in Private Pharmacies, Pharmacies of Public, Private and Military Hospitals, EOPYY Pharmacies, Wholesale Pharmacies, Pharmaceutical and Cosmetics companies for the promotion of products, Pharmaceutical industries, Cosmetics & Pharmaceutical manufacturing laboratories, Public Utilities, the National Organisation, and Research Centres.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector according to the Presidential Decree no. 50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol. A/5-3-2001), as currently in force.
