- Plan and implement special crisis management tactics.
- Work under the supervision of a physician with orderliness, responsibility, team spirit and confidentiality.
- Harmoniously collaborate with the entire treatment team.
- Support and defend the mentally ill and their families.
- Respectfully handle diversity and interculturalism.
