- Analyse political systems regimes / political ideologies of traditional and modern forms, and formulate the principles related to the organisation and structure of the state within the context of said political realities.
- Explain the role of key organisations and institutions contributing to the formation of international relations among states.
- Analyse the operation of communication models, communication techniques, and public relations.

SKILLS

- Prepare or deliver correct information content (news or column), on the domestic or international reality, through the constructive use of domestic or international sources and depending on the specifics of the information-related media (newspaper, magazine, radio, television, website) where it will be posted.
- Apply techniques and methods for the effective pagination of a document (creating page layouts, prioritising, and titling issues, selecting, selection and processing photos), to the best promotion of the journalistic content.
- Hold and make use of all tools of social media aiming at extending the journalistic role thereof in the context of alternative-participatory forms of journalism of the 21st century.
- Apply effective public relation communication techniques or actions.
- · Readily handle applications related to computer use.

COMPETENCES

- Serve the journalistic profession based on the current rules of journalistic ethics (at national and international level), as well as the principles set out in the relevant laws on media.
- Constructively collaborate with colleagues, managers, and the technical staff of a journalistic medium, to build a sound journalistic project.
- Revise and renew journalism practices based on technological developments and the new trends in the communication field.
- Produce journalistic work under conditions imposed by unexpected-continuous relocations and irregular hours.
- Perform the journalistic role based on the target group and the policy of the journalism organisation where graduates are employed, without betraying the profession's principles and violating journalistic ethics.
- · Seek and maintain constant contact with news events in the domestic and international communication field.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate ³

The holder of the Diploma of this specialisation can be employed as a journalist, reporter or presenter of shows and news on TV channels and radio stations, as a journalist or reporter in newspapers, in the periodical press, websites, news agencies, as a contact person for press offices of service, companies, associations, etc.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector according to the Presidential Decree no. 50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol. A/5-3-2001), as currently in force.

The Certificate supplement provides additional information about the certificate and does not have any legal status in itself. Its format is based on the Decision (EU) 2018/646 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 April 2018 on a common framework for the provision of better services for skills and qualifications (Europass) and repealing Decision No 2241/2004/EC.
