- · Report protection measures in the event of fire, flood, earthquake and human-caused hazards.
- Assess the risk of emergencies and prioritise their actions.
- Distinguish the main symptoms of health problems.
- Communicate satisfactory in at least one foreign language, and knows professional terminology.

SKILLS

- Organise the security and protection of museums and archaeological sites.
- Operate electronic security systems to monitor premises and infrastructure.
- Prepare precise written reports regarding events and situations.
- Analyse information about conditions and events.
- · Apply basic principles of self-defence.
- Apply basic principles of transport and safe handling of antiquities and works of art.
- Verify the access of staff and the public based on the security zones of premises and infrastructure.
- Take immediate and effective action if an alarm is activated (for actual reasons or due to error).
- · Maintain the smooth operation of security systems and restore it in case of failure.
- Implement the contingency plan (in the event of earthquake, fire, flood, armed conflict) in order to protect visitors and staff, collections, facilities and equipment.

- · Act pursuant to the code of professional ethics, based on national and international standards.
- Act in agreement with the policies and procedures of the employer organisation.
- · Be constantly alert and respond immediately when necessary.
