KNOWLEDGE

- Recognise the basic elements of drawing, colour, sketching and the principles of artistic composition.
- Explain the applications of graphic design.
- Recognise the main aesthetic periods of works of art.
- Identify the types of printed and electronic media (multimedia).
- List the printing methods and describe the production stages of pre-printing, printing and post-printing.
- Indicate the necessary equipment for the production of audio visual works.
- Recognise colouring models used for the production of printed and audio visual applications.
- Distinguish features, such as fonts, images, animation, sound, video and graphics.
- Describe the tools and the environment of digital software used for the creation and development of applications for printer media, multimedia, and web pages.

SKILLS

- Design graphic art solutions for professional applications (logotypes, leaflets, posters, web pages, social networking, etc.).
- Using the appropriate digital software, compose texts, images and graphics for the creation of digital files to be printed.
- Using the appropriate digital software, compose images, animation, texts, graphics, sound and video for the creation of audio visual works.
- Justify the selection of each visual art solutions suggested.
- Intervene creatively during the production of printed material and multimedia applications.

COMPETENCES

- Follow instructions by the artistic curator during the performance of duties, understand how to implement said instructions, and ensure compliance with the timetables set.
- Work independently, assuming responsibility for the completion and quality of any works undertaken.
- Collaborate with other specialists, such as copy editors, illustrators, software developers, typographers, etc., for the implementation of complex projects.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate ³

The VET graduate of this specialty can work as a graphic designer in advertising and publishing companies, printing houses, institutions, public organisations and bodies, and design printed material for the needs of displaying information and messages. The holder can also work as an audio visual projects graphic designer in companies producing commercials, television and motion pictures, in television stations, etc. Finally, the holder may also work as a freelancer in their own studio. The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector according to the Presidential Decree no. 50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol. A/5-3-2001), as in effect.

The Certificate supplement provides additional information about the certificate and does not have any legal status in itself. Its format is based on the Decision (EU) 2018/646 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 April 2018 on a common framework for the provision of better services for skills and qualifications (Europass) and repealing Decision No 2241/2004/EC.
