KNOWLEDGE

- Understand the freehand drawing elements, of colour and the visual composition principles.
- Number the materials and their characteristics (types of colours, papers etc) used for hand-drawn illustration.
- Distinguish the basic visual art trends to this day and the modern trends illustration, caricature, comics
- Determine the traditional and modern printing methods.
- Recognize the colour models used in all stages of productive illustration.
- Recount the narration techniques for developing a scenario and a comics text.
- Draws key elements of a human figure anatomy in various stances of design and foreshortening due to perspective.
- Determine the appropriate tools and software required for digital processing of an image.
- Describe the basic illustration techniques for books, daily or regular press, posters etc

- Illustrates books, daily and regular press, posters, advertising brochures, pages for multimedia applications, webpages etc
- Draw sketches, caricatures, comics etc.
- Manage the appropriate tools and materials for hand-made illustration.
- Process drafts using the appropriate software with characters, scene images, background etc
- Compose a large board with small sketches and discourses in a successive series of scenes aimed at narrating a story (storyboard).

- Work autonomously and be responsible for the work quality.
- Cooperate with other specialties such as authors, editors, directors, photographers, pressmen to complete complex projects.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate 3

The VET graduate of this specialty may work as illustrator in advertising and publishing companies-newspapers, magazines, books-foundations, public organizations and anybody involved in the illustration of any topic related to the needs of projecting information and messages. In addition he or she may also work as illustrator of audiovisual projects in advertising movies production companies, televised and cinematographic movies, in TV stations etc. Finally, graduates may work as freelances owning their own laboratory.

The recognition of I.E.K Diploma as a formal qualification for recruitment in the public sector is governed by virtue of the P.D 50/2001 (Government Gazette. 39 / A' / 5-3-2001), as in effect.

The Certificate supplement provides additional information about the certificate. It does not have any legal status in itself.
