- Describe grapes growing cycle, from the flowering period until full ripening.
- Know the stages of must extraction and vinification, as well as wine preservation, clarification, filtration, bottling and ageing methods.
- Present the procedure for making white, rosé and red wines.
- Conduct organoleptic testing and evaluation of the wine and any defects.
- Know Greek and international wine legislation (PDO, PGI, TRADITIONAL WINES AND PDO ZONES).

SKILLS

- Perform and suggest the cultivation works and care of the vine, using suitable tools with accuracy.
- Undertake and conduct quality control to the wine products.
- Identify the basic illnesses of grape diseases.

COMPETENCES

- Sufficiently manage the vine and wine products.
- Abide by the wine legislation.
- Ensure smooth alcoholic fermentation at all stages of wine making.
- Work responsibly, either independently or within a team.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate ³

The holder of this diploma can work in viticultural and/or wine-making companies, in the promotion and distribution of wine products, in trade and standardisation institutions, in oenological laboratories, and the Ministry of Rural Development and Food.

The Vocational Training Diploma is recognised as a qualification for appointment in the public sector according to the Presidential Decree no. 50/2001 (Greek Official Gazette 39/Vol. A/5-3-2001), as currently in force.
