Learning outcomes: Knowledge, skills and competences A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

KNOWLEDGE

- Classify cameras in analogue and digital ones and report on their basic categories.
- List the types of films depending on wavelength recordings and recount their attributes.
- Identify a photo camera operation and accessories.
- Name the measurement techniques and manage the natural and artificial lighting.
- Recognize the way visual communication functions in relation to the specialty.
- Describe the stages of transferring the visual image into a black-white and coloured film.

SKILLS

- Handle, set, and maintain every photographic printing camera for a black-white or coloured printing.
- Create photographic photosensitive surfaces.
- Develop films and print black-white photos in a dark room laboratory.
- Develop coloured films and print coloured photos in a coloured dark room laboratory.
- Take all necessary safety measures at the workplace.
- Apply the production stages of advertising photography.

COMPETENCES

- Follow the instructions by the artistic supervisor or technical director when performing duties and understand the way to apply instructions.
- Cooperate with other technicians in charge of other stages of production, such as graphic designers, advertisers etc for correct and qualitative photo printing.
- Respect the basic health and safety rules at the workplace.
- Work individually or with an assistant depending on the type of processing a photographic image.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate³

The VET graduate of this specialty may work in organized photography laboratories involved in processing and printing a photographic image, in the public and private sector and as a freelance.

The Diploma is recognized as a formal qualification for recruitment in the public sector in the Secondary Education graduate category, by virtue of the PD 50/2001 (Government Gazette 39/A[']/5-3-2001), as in effect.
