- Recognize the basic types of yarn and fabrics and their use.
- Describe the stages of developing and presenting a clothing collection.
- Understand and analyze the fabric cutting stages.
- Determine in detail the stages of garment assembly.

SKILLS

- Design a clothing collection and choose the appropriate fabrics for said collection.
- Manufacture the model sketches for cutting (base patterns) to prepare basic clothing.
- Convert the model sketches for cutting (base patterns) into other original pattern designs.
- Create pattern grading for each garment sketch.
- Interpret the garment model sketches and produce the corresponding pattern.
- Assemble garments with the use of sewing machines for clothing production.

COMPETENCES

- Understand the market needs.
- Cooperate with all stakeholders for clothing products production and promotion.
- Be endowed with aesthetics to design a garments collection.
- Understand, process and apply fashion trends.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate ³

The VET graduate of this specialty may be employed in clothing production and design enterprises (Industries, craftmanships, workshops, fashion houses, organizations, Ministries, fashion magazines, training establishments with workshops for clothing items design and production, in clothing sales enterprises, as assistant costumer, assistant fashion consultant and as freelance professional for clothing items creation and promotion.

The Diploma is recognized as a formal qualification for recruitment in the public sector in the Secondary Education graduate category by virtue of the PD 50/2001 (Government Gazette 39/A'/5-3-2001), as in effect.
